Sir/Madam,

With reference to your online application dated 27/06/2012 on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the sanction for Composite Provisional Affiliation for Secondary School Examination of the Board for a period of three years w.e.f. 01/04/2013 to 31/03/2016.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions -

1. "School will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT for the middle classes".
2. The school will implement Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) as per the schemes of the Board upto Classes X vide Circular No. 39/20-09-2009 dated 20.09.2009 in the school.
3. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State Govt./UT.
4. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.
5. The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time to time
6. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under -

(d) School running on bigger campus of more than 02 acres, the number of students shall be restricted as per the actual facilities in the school which shall be proportionate to the optimum number mentioned at (a), (b) and (c) above.

(e) Schools running on less than 01 acre campus shall restrict number of students as follows -

7. The School will not sponsor candidates for Board's examination of any other School/Branch, which is not affiliated.
8. The school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Board's class X Examination from the year mentioned above without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates. Failure to do so will lead to *suo moto* withdrawal of the affiliation of the school for secondary Examination granted by the Board.
9. The school should not start Class XI/XII without written approval of the Board. The Board shall not be responsible for any consequences in case class XI/XII is started without following the Affiliation Bye Laws and obtaining the prior approval of the Board.
10. The school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per

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- 11 Service conditions, pay and allowances and other benefits to the employees of the school shall be at least at par with that of corresponding categories of employees working in Government Schools of the State in which the school is located. An undertaking to this effect be sent to C.B.S.E.
- 12 Service agreement be executed with the staff as per norms generally accepted by the State Government concerned
- 13 The school will help the Board in the smooth conduct of the examination by providing the necessary accommodations i.e. Rooms, Halls, etc. available in the school premises and furniture at its disposal for holding its examinations free of charges if required
- 14 The school will spare sufficient teachers, for invigilation purpose at the examinations of the Board, as may be required.
- 15 The school will spare its teachers for evaluation of answer-books for the Board's examinations, if required
- 16 The school will provide Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board.
- 17 The school will abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the State Government concerned
- 18 The school should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers or computer student ratio of 1:20 and proper software alongwith facility of Broad Band Connectivity with the feature of 'internet always on' from any service provider.
- 19 The school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'persons with disabilities act -1995'.
- 20 The school and its records shall be opened for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time
- 21 The rate of tuition fee and other fees charged should be commensurate with the facilities provided
- 22 The admission to the school shall be opened to all without any discrimination on the ground of religion, cast or race, place of birth or any of them
- 23 No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school
- 24 The school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting, Drinking water, Sanitation, Transportation, etc
- 25 The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared in the name of school, as per rules. A copy each of the Statements of Accounts should be sent to the Board every year
- 26 The affiliation Code Number allotted to your school is 1030687. This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with the Board.
- 27 The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws.
28. The school will apply for further Extension of Provisional Affiliation 'on online' through www.cbseaff.nic.in with the prescribed fee of ₹25,000/- and other essential documents before 30th June of the preceding year before the expiry of the date of provisional affiliation.
29. The school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Board's class X Examination from the year mentioned above without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates. Failure to do so will lead to *suo moto* withdrawal of the affiliation of the school for secondary Examination granted by the Board.
30. The school has been granted affiliation upto Secondary level w.e.f. 01.04.2013 accordingly it has become eligible to open CBSE pattern classes IX from the session 2013-14 and 1st Batch of class X of the school will be appearing at the CBSE Examination to be held in the year 2015.


Other Conditions:

Conditions for which compliance to be submitted within three months from the date of issue of sanction letter:-

1. Running starting of Class IX/X & XI/XII without prior Provisional Affiliation upto Secondary level/Sr. Secondary level from the Board would be unauthorized and school shall be responsible for the consequences arising out of it.
2. Non-submission of application for extension of provisional affiliation by 30th June of the year preceding to the year by which provisional affiliation granted, expires, would also attract violation of provisions of Affiliation Bye-laws.
3. School will not prepare any student/start any class for any other Board except CBSE from their CBSE Affiliated school building/premises.
4. The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one society/ Management/ Trust to another Society/ Management/ Trust through agreement/sale deed and the school shall not be closed down in the same premises. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly the Board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effect.
5. Pay & Allowances to staff should be revised from time to time to bring it at par with that to State Government.
6. The service conditions be strictly followed as per State Education Act and Staff be given appointment/confirmation letters etc. accordingly.
7. 5-6 names of persons (at least 2-3 from KV/JNV) not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee.
8. The school shall maintain section teacher ratio at least 1:1.5 at each level i.e. Primary (I-V) Secondary (VI-X) and Sr. Secondary (XI-XII).
9. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of woman from sexual harassment at the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No 666-70 of 1992 Vishaska and other State of Rajasthan and others delivered on 13.8.1997.
10. The school shall maintain Reserve Fund in the joint names of the Manager of the school concerned and the Secretary of the Board in the scheduled Bank to the extent indicated below:-

33. Special conditions to be complied within three months:-

- Every School should organize at least one week training programme for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Govt. or by any agency identified by the Board.
- Every institute will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students.
- The school is required to appoint more trained and qualified teacher on permanent basis and also to maintained teachers section ratio i.e. 1.5 teacher per section. Submit revised staff list.
- The school is required to submit a list of enrolment of students class/section wise.
- The school is required to send Principal/teachers for CCE, in-service, refreshers/re-orientation programme to update their knowledge and teaching skills.
- The school is required to procure more books for library i.e. 05 books per student.
- The school is required to pay salary, DA and other allowances as per State Govt./VIth pay commission and provide a copy of acquittance roll for the last 03 months and documents evidence that the salaries are being paid through bank by single banker cheque.





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18. The genuineness of information / documents / data submitted shall be of school and in case, if found otherwise the school shall invite action as per affiliation Bye laws-2018

21. The extension of affiliation is being granted as one time measure. However, the cases where the Show Cause Notice was communicated or grievance / legal cases are pending against the school, the Board will take appropriate decision in this matter
22. The school shall renew all mandatory safety certificate i.e Safe Drinking Water & Health and Hygiene certificate, Fire Safety Certificate and Building Safety Certificate from concerned Govt authorities time to time
23. The school shall also maintain record of certificate, compliances, data and other records/information and shall be fully responsible to produce all such records before Board and appropriate Government Authorities when asked for, failing which necessary action shall be taken as per Affiliation-Bye-Laws of the Board. The school shall also be liable for action by the appropriate Govt., in case of violation / non-compliance of the concerned Govt. norms

In view of current COVID-19 pandemic which has most severely affected the normal functioning of schools in the country, however, the school is pursuing to provide extension of affiliation so as to avoid any difficulty for the purpose of admission /registration/ obtaining loan/renewal of various safety certificates from appropriate state authorities.

Therefore, the competent authority of the Board after due consideration has accorded approval for extension of Affiliation based on details/data submitted by school in online application for a further period of 5 years subject to fulfilment of following conditions:

- The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time.
- The School is required to apply online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws, 2018.
- The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per appendix III issued by District Education Officer (DEO) /equivalent officer.
- The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff development and other co-curricular areas.
- The school should go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites i.e. <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates. The School is expected to see all circulars on these CBSE websites regularly.
- The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students. The school will ensure that Fire, Building, health and sanitation and safe drinking water certificates are renewed from time to time, as per norms.
- Admission to the school is to be restricted as per relevant rules of Examination Bye-laws and rule 2.4.5, 2.6.5, 7.1, 7.2, 8.4.2, 8.4.10 & other relevant rules of Affiliation bye laws.
- The school is required to follow rule No.2.4.7 and 2.4.8 of Affiliation Bye Laws regarding Books and Quality of Education.
- The number of sections may be restricted as per the Appendix V of the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board. For increase in number of sections, the School shall apply online to the Board as per rule 15.7 of Affiliation Bye laws.
- The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. The school shall also be liable to bear all legal charges incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances.
- The school must strive to promote conservation of environment on their campus through rain water harvesting, segregation of waste at source, recycling of organic waste, proper disposal of waste including electronic waste, use of energy saving and energy efficient electrical equipment, greening of campus, use of solar energy, education and awareness amongst children on environment conservation and cleanliness etc.
- The school shall submit their information through Online Affiliated School Information System (OASIS) as per details given in circular no. affiliation-06/2018 dated 24.04.2018. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website: www.cbse.nic.in
- The optimum Section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 as well as student teacher ratio of 30:1 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
- Every affiliated school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Boards Class X and Class XII examinations from the year mentioned while granting affiliation/up-gradation regularly without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates.
- Running of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not permitted by the Board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
- The Manager and the Principal of the school shall be jointly responsible for the authenticity of the online/offline documents/information/data submitted by the School to the Board.
- Apart from rules to be adhered to by the school as mentioned above for drawing specific attention of the school authorities, the school authorities are required to acquaint themselves with all the rules contained in Affiliation & Examination Bye-laws and circulars/guidelines/notification issued by the Board from time to time.
